WELCOME TO THE 2021' 49r FESTIVAL

YOU ARE ASSIGNED BOOTH/SPACE: _____ please see the attached Map.

***We have made every attempt to honor all booth requests, please understand booth assignments may be changed the day of the event**

We request you set up on Friday, September 17th; Volunteers will be available from 2:00pm to 8:00pm to direct you to your assigned spot. Groveland Community Services District will NOT assume any liability for Security of your vehicle or personal items. If you plan to arrive and set up on Friday, you must plan for the security of your items and personal property. **Your Signature on the attached release of Liability form is mandatory (present it at the Yosemite HWY 120 Chamber booth).**

If you plan to arrive on Saturday September 18th at Mary Laveroni Community Park, Highway 120, Groveland, the day of the event, you must arrive between 6am and 7:30am. **All vehicles must be off the field by 8am-NO Exceptions; County Health Requirement** (your help in making this annual event a safe and successful one is greatly appreciated).

Upon arrival, unload your vehicle and then move it to the parking lot by the Museum, return and complete your set up (volunteers will direct your exit path), this will help ensure a smooth flow of vendors and vehicles.

The event begins immediately following the parade 9-10am. For the safety of all guests and event participants, you will not be allowed to bring your vehicle into the event area until the event is over at 5pm-we appreciate your not tearing down your booth prior to the event closure.

NOTE:

- Booth spaces are 10x10 (your tent/canopy) do not exceed the chalking outline (Do not create your own space please)
- All vendors are required to bring their own "tent" or "canopy, table and chairs
- Vendors who have requested power-must bring a UL rated 3 prong extension cord-we recommend 100' (All extension cords must be covered to prevent trip hazards)
- No pets allowed within 20' of Food Booths (*you must have bags with you to pick up any pet waste)
- Vendors who requested water-bring a clean container to transport-water bibs will be marked
- Please try and avoid using long spikes to secure your tent/canopy- sprinkler systems underground
- You are responsible for cleaning up your booth area, trash containers will be available (Thank you)
- No overnight trailers allowed the day of the event (PML camp ground available approximately 2.5 miles down the road, please plan accordingly)
- No generators allowed
- Anyone using coals, they must be completely out before disposal (all fires must be attended at all times)
- Please be courteous and smoke only in designated areas, dispose of butts properly
- Parents, remember that you are held responsible for the actions of your minor children

If you have any questions during the day, please check in at the Yosemite Chamber of Commerce booth. **Food vendors must bring their Tuolumne County Health Department certificate with them.**

We look forward to seeing you September 18th for another safe and successful Family event.
